Looking back to 2023, I was thrilled to clinch the Junior Auto Grass Championship title in a Toyota Yaris.




Among over 105 talented juniors at the Autograss National Junior Championships, I secured a strong 6th place finish and proudly emerged as the top-ranked female in the standings.

My passion for improving my skills also led me to the SIM Motorsport Race School, where I set many lap records during coaching sessions and won the coveted win for the overall academy.

These efforts earned me the "Young Gun" award for the most improved Junior driver and the honour of carrying the prestigious "1" number as the top points scorer in my club.
